

## City Of Rathdrum Park Rules

- No glass containers allowed in parks
- Alcohol is permitted in plastic or aluminum containers only.
- No dogs or pets allowed in parks.
- No motorized vehicles with the exception of handicap vehicles.
- No open fires, explosives or fireworks.
- No overnight parking or camping.
- No loud or disturbing noises that may interfere the enjoyment of other park visitors.
- No littering, please use trash receptacles.
- No golfing.
- The use of metal detectors is strictly prohibited.
- Destruction or vandalism is a crime and violators will be prosecuted.

# Park Information

## City Park



This quaint park lined with shady trees is located along Hwy 53 at 15456 N Latah St. The Rathdrum Creek runs through the middle of the park making it a popular choice for weddings, company parties, and family gatherings. The park features a playground, gazebo, horseshoe pits, water feature and a full

service pavilion. The park pavilion and gazebo can be rented out for family events or business parties.

## Majestic Park

Majestic Park is located at the Southeastern part of the city limits at 5400 W. Majestic Avenue. Built in 2012, Majestic Park is the city's newest park and includes a splash park, playground, two softball fields and a breathtaking view of Rathdrum Mountain. The splash-park makes Majestic Park a popular destination for families looking for some fun in the sun.



## Roth Park

After a busy day at work, home, or school, enjoy this petit quiet park located at 14475 N. Roth Court, off of Hwy 41 along Montana St, in Roth Addition. This is the perfect park for picnicking, playing



basketball & family barbecues.

## Goodness Grows Community Garden

Enjoy eye catching colors, fragrant smells and beautiful flowers, all within the seasonal vegetable gardens. If your taking a summer walk, this is an excellent place to visit in the downtown Rathdrum area. Bring a sack lunch and enjoy the park from the pergola!



## Stub Myer Park

Stub Myer Park is one of the largest parks within the city of Rathdrum. It offers three baseball/softball fields, a large playground, a volleyball court, concession stand, and a picnic shelter. The concession stand, which was recently remodeled, is equipped with a cooler, sink and lots of counter top space. Both the concession stand and picnic shelter are available to rent for your event. The park is located West of Hwy 41 on Montana St.

## Thayer Park

One of the newest additions to the Rathdrum community; this wide open space is mostly used for youth soccer and has a large playground that features a climbing wall. Thayer Park is located in the Cooper Valley Estates at 6896 Winchester. Turn east on Pine from Highway 41.



## John Brown Sports Complex

This park is home to Cooper "baseball" Field and is located on Main St. between John Brown Elementary and Lakeland Junior High. This city owned complex has a nearby playground, tennis court, and basketball hoops.

## Rathdrum Skate Park

The skate park is located at 7851 Main St. next to the Rathdrum Parks & Recreation office. Skate Park hours are sun-up to sun-down. Hours of operation are strictly enforced.
