

IN THE BEGINNING ...

A man by the name of A.W. Post allowed burials on his land. On January 28, 1892 he named it Pinegrove Cemetery. When you purchased a lot for \$ 5—\$10 dollars you were given a deed to that piece of property.



In 1980 the streets and alley ways were dedicated to the public.

DID YOU KNOW ...

- Several Civil War Veterans are buried within Pinegrove Cemetery.
- The oldest grave: Harry Nicholls November 2, 1886.
- No one knows why a man buried here went by two different names, Dick McGinty and Richard E. McLeady, he died April 29, 1957.
- One headstone simply reads, Grandma Hayes 1848-1925.




Pinegrove Cemetery is one of the oldest cemeteries in both Kootenai and Bonner County.



The cemetery directory is dedicated to a much appreciated man named Lyal “Stub” Myers. This man spent many years of volunteer work at Pinegrove Cemetery.

A local Elementary school is named after a woman named Betty Kiefer who played an important role within the community. She is buried in the new section of the cemetery.



Charles Wesley Wood, is the town’s Namesake. Rathdrum was originally called Westwood until the late 1890’s. The town was also the original county seat for Kootenai County.

Until approximately 1910, Bonner County was part of Kootenai County. Earlier records are incomplete.
